BEFORE THE SONG BEGINS, JEENALD TALKS BACK TO SAMANTHA, WHO IS TEACHING THE CLASS UNTIL A CERTIFIED TEACHER CAN BE HIRED. AS A PUNISHMENT, JEENALD IS MADE TO PLAY THE PART OF JESUS CHRIST FOR A PLAY-WITHIN-A-PLAY THAT INTENDS TO TEACH ABOUT THE PARABLES.

SAMANTHA DRESSES JEENALD IN A WHITE OVERSIZED SHIRT, A RED SASH, AND A "CROWN OF THORNS" MADE OF PIPE CLEANERS. HE CRINGES.
